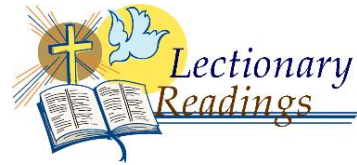

After finishing high school at McNair High in 1994, Simone went to West Georgia College and earned a degree in Finance. In 2002 Simone achieved a Masters degree from the Keller Graduate School of Management. Mom now lives in New York and Dad is here in Atlanta.

Since graduating with her advanced degree, Simone has been employed in the Atlanta area with several different firms. Her last job was with Premiere Global Services, a telecommunication company in Alpharetta. She worked in the corporate world for approximately ten years before entering Columbia Seminary.

Her call to do God's work began when Simone was a child. Even as she worked in the corporate world, she knew that there was something else for her. She joined Pleasant Hill Presbyterian, where she has been very active with the youth groups. Mission trips and other outreach programs fulfilled her life more than anything else ever had. Two trips to Honduras and various conversations about the place of God in our lives sent her to Columbia in 2010.

Simone's life now is busy, busy! In addition to her 15 hours/week at CNC—(Wednesdays and Sundays) and her studies, Simone works at the Atlanta Presbytery office as a contract accountant and does a work/study job at the seminary library. She is also active in the Student Council at Columbia Seminary and is Vice President of the African Heritage Seminarian Association.

In what little leisure time she has, Simone enjoys BBQ's with friends, spontaneous travel to refresh and relax, movies, and action books.
